SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT - RESIDENTIAL AREAS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The City Commission has authorized a sidewalk repair program for commercial areas of the City.
2. The City will pay \$4.00 per foot for each individual project, provided the sidewalk to be replaced is at least 4' wide.
3. The construction guidelines on residential sidewalks will be 5 1/2 sack cement in strength, 4" thickness and a minimum of 4 feet in width. A copy of the concrete invoice must be presented for verification of the cement mix before any reimbursement is made. If adjoining sidewalks are more or less than 4 feet in width, the City staff shall be contacted in regards to special conditions covering these situations.
4. A contractor can be secured by the property owner to do the sidewalk construction or the property owner can complete the installation himself, if qualified. Either the contractor or the property owner will be responsible for form materials for the sidewalk construction.
5. The property owner or contractor will be responsible for hauling off the old concrete sidewalk material.
6. The City will provide an inspector to review the installation of the sidewalk.
7. This project is for the replacement of the horizontal front footage that runs in front of an individual residence or in the case of a corner lot, along the side of the residence. No spot replacement of sidewalk sections will be considered.
8. Payment to individual property owners will be made by the City after inspection of the completed project.
9. We understand that some unusual situations can develop that are not covered in these general conditions. Such situations will be handled by the City staff when and if they occur.
