

## CITY OF GARNETT SPRING/FALL CLEAN-UP WEEK

The Garnett City Commission designates one week in the spring and one week in the fall as Clean-Up Week. Open burning may held during this designated week, weather permitting.

During Clean-Up Week and Open Burning, the following guidelines will be followed:

### **OPEN BURNING**

**Residents must notify the Police Dispatch Office by calling 448-6823 before you start burning.**

### COMMERCIAL PICK-UP

- A. Only items which will be taken by the Anderson County Landfill which include refrigerators, hot water heaters, lawn mowers, etc. will be picked up. Pick-up limited to a combination of five (5) items. **Please call City Hall to be placed on a list (448-5496).**
- B. Other items to be picked up would include cardboard boxes, cans, bottles, paper and brush.

### RESIDENTIAL PICK-UP

- A. Crews will start at the north end of town and proceed south until the entire town is covered. **CITY CREWS WILL NOT GO BACK IF THEY HAVE ALREADY BEEN THROUGH THAT PARTICULAR AREA.**
- B. The following items must be placed in separate piles:
  - 1. Brush
  - 2. Leaves and lawn clippings
  - 3. Paper
  - 4. Metal (No Car or Vehicle Parts)
  - 5. Appliances
  - 6. Furniture
  - 7. Lumber
  - 8. Rock/Concrete
  - 9. Shingles
  - 10. Sheet Rock

**(IF ITEMS ARE NOT PLACED IN SEPARATE PILES, THEY WILL NOT BE PICKED UP)**

Please keep fall clean-up materials separate from weekly solid waste trash that is taken by the refuse department.

**NOTE: ANY APPLIANCES, SUCH AS, REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS, ETC., WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF THEY CONTAIN FREON.**

**DILAPIDATED BUILDINGS THAT HAVE BEEN DEMOLISHED WILL NOT BE TAKEN. BATTERIES, PAINT OR ANY OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS WILL NOT BE TAKEN.**
