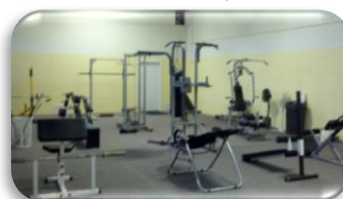

Senior Citizen (55 & over) \$10/month

Daily Fee, all ages \$ 2

*Family of four includes mother, father
and two kids or a single parent and
three kids. Any additional kids up to
the age of 18 years of age will be an
additional \$10 per month. A married
couple will qualify for the family plan.

Any child 11 years of age and under
cannot use the facility without being
accompanied by a parent, legal
guardian or adult. No fee will be
charged for those under the age of 11.
However, if the parent, legal guardian
or adult accompanying someone in this
age group wants to use the facility,
they must have a membership or pay a
daily/monthly fee.
